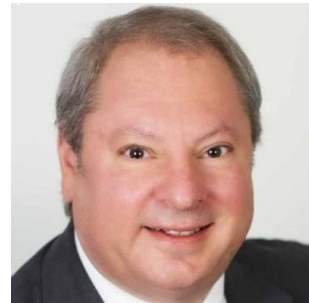
Trip to Carowinds
